

Marketing & Communications Officer Volunteer Description

The British Baseball Federation is looking to appoint a volunteer part time Marketing and Communications Officer. This is an exciting opportunity for any individual looking to help promote baseball during one of the most anticipated years in British Baseball history including the 2023 London Series and World Baseball Classic

This role will require 1-2 hours of attention each week, for a period at least six months, with a possible extension to twelve months.

Main purpose of the role:

The purpose of the Marketing Officer will be to assist the Board of the British Baseball Federation in a marketing and communications role.

The Officer's primary purpose will be to promote the Federation's activities, raising brand awareness of the Federation as well as growing the Federation's visibility within the UK and internationally.

These brands include Great Britain Baseball, BBF-affiliated Baseball Leagues and the Federation itself.

Time Commitment:

Approximately 1-2 hours each week.

Essential Requirements:

- · Content Creation experience, both digital and offline
- basic IT skills
- A confident communicator
- Familiarity with Facebook, Twitter and Instagram, as well as other communication platforms

Desirable Requirements:

- Experience with Squarespace and/or other similar website platforms

- Experience using social media management systems such as Content Cal or Hootsuite.
- Familiarity with Adobe Photoshop or similar tools
- Familiarity with Adobe Premiere or similar tools

Operating and developing the British Baseball Federation's Marketing with a particular focus on:

- Creating content for the Federation's online assets
- Promoting the image and awareness of British Baseball nationally and internationally.
- Building and maintaining the BBF's online assets.
- Working and coordinating content with BaseballSoftballUK, MLB and UK Sport media teams.
- Creating national publicity for baseball.
- Creating and preparing regular news bulletins for the membership.
